BRIEF SCENARIO OF INCIDENT: Late this morning emergency dispatchers received reports of smoke and flame seen at this address. A neighbor had checked to see if the home was occupied, after seeing smoke, and called 911. Central Fire District firefighters arrived on scene to see smoke and fire showing above the roof of the home. Making their way to the rear of the structure, firefighters found the homeowner extinguishing the flames with a garden hose. The fire was confined to a storage area built onto the corner of the home. The fire was quickly extinguished and exterior walls were breached to check for fire extension. No fire damage was found in the exterior of the home. Damage was confined to the storage area and its contents.
