TYPE OF INCIDENT: Wildland Fire

LOCATION OF INCIDENT: Brommer Street (between 30th Ave. & Lisa Lane)

OCCUPANT/OWNER OF PROPERTY: Santa Cruz County

BRIEF SCENARIO OF INCIDENT: Several calls were made this afternoon to 911 dispatchers reporting grass and brush on fire near Brommer Street Park. Central Fire District Personnel responded to the area to find approximately one quarter acre of brush burning towards a wooded area. Firefighters quickly encircled the fire with hose lines and prevented it from spreading further. The area was wetted down thoroughly and overhauled to prevent and rekindling by burning embers.
